
Lockyer Valley Flood Mitigation Works

The Lockyer Valley Flood Management Plan identifies mitigation measures to increase flood immunity and address the increasing damage costs that are an unsustainable burden on the community.

Current key projects include the Laidley Flood Mitigation Strategy and the Withcott Flood Mitigation Scheme.

Laidley Flood Mitigation Strategy is to improve both storage and conveyance of the system resulting in fewer impacts in more extreme flooding scenarios. Resultant benefits of the project are more resilient facilities and extensive open space.

Withcott Flood Mitigation Scheme involves an increase in the conveyance and capacity of Gatton Creek in Withcott. The identified improvements would assist access to Toowoomba in heavy rain events and assist in business as usual along this section of Toowoomba Connection Road.
