
Strengthening Grantham **Highway Access**



PROPONENT

Catalytic road infrastructure is required to provide safe and flood free access from Grantham to the Warrego Highway.

The road infrastructure will provide an evacuation route from the Grantham township, as planned road linkages have not been constructed. During flood events Grantham is isolated, leaving residents without access to food, medicine and other essential services.

Access to the Warrego Highway also will assist to activate land for employment uses and create a complete community, and will add to the work already completed in relocating the residents of Grantham to a safe area.

- A safe, flood free transport route during disaster events providing access for emergency vehicles and the public.
- Supporting regional growth and building resilience to disaster events.
- Continue the development of Grantham in a safe location, and realise opportunities to nurture and enrich the culture of Grantham.
